

Special provisions for drivers

When driving a vehicle within the Plant, observe the highway code, road signs and speed limit of 25km/hr (3km/hr when reverse).

Stop the vehicles at the loading and unloading sites and use only the reserved parking lots for parking.

Co-driver is only allowed to enter the loading and unloading area in the vehicle cab.

Vehicle parking or staying at distance less than 3m from the track is prohibited.

Risk, presenting a threat to you

Some sites within the area of Lime plant Slavec are classified as the hazardous work sites with the following risk factors:

- noise
- chemical substances (solid limestone, dolomite and lime oxide aerosols)

Due to the above reasons, you are obliged to wear the suitable PPE at identified workplaces.



Earmuffs



Respirator



Safety gloves

Lime is an irritant. The lime in form of dust and in mixture with water irritates eyes, air passages and skin. Direct contact with eyes can result in serious eye damage.

If you get lime in your eyes, use your personal Diphoterine kit or wash eyes with fresh water for at least 15 minutes.

Never flush eyes with water before Diphoterine, it reduces the effect of the product

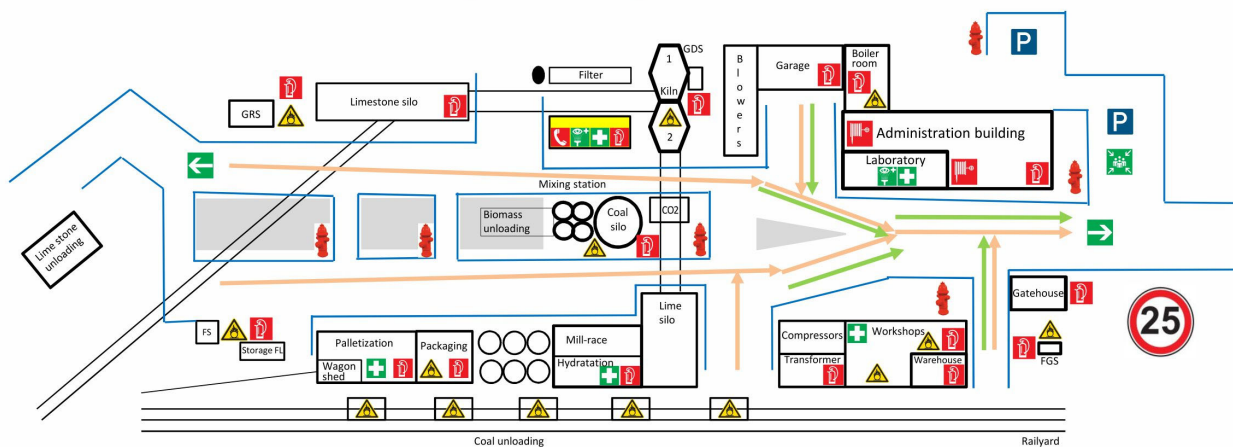
The eye showers are present in the Limekiln Slavec.

Locations of eye showers:

- control room ground floor
- lab

After eye treatment (Diphoterine or wash eyes with fresh water) it is necessary to visit a doctor (hospital) for further treatment!
